We are seeking local artists to fill the following roles:

ADULT ENSEMBLE

18 years of age and older. Any vocal range. Seeking artists who enjoy singing harmonies and are comfortable moving. Ensemble members will portray nuns, party guests, servants, soldiers and more. **The ability to play a musical instrument is an asset.**

VON TRAPP CHILDREN

Child performers will be cast in the following roles:

Friedrich	14 years old. Tough exterior, trying to be "the man" of the family.
Louisa	13 years old. Rebellious attitude.
Kurt	10 years old. Mischievous.
Brigitta	9 years old. Intelligent and loves to read.
Marta	7 years old. Sweet and gentle.
Gretl	6 years old. The youngest.

The time commitment extends on a part-time basis from November 4 – December 11, 2019.

Rehearsals begin November 4, 2019 through until November 27. Local artists will be required both after school/work and on weekends. The production runs at the Sagebrush Theatre from November 28 - December 11, 2019, with both evening and matinee performances.
